

“Three Days and Three Nights”

Originally I thought Yeshua was crucified on the 14th of Aviv, which was a Wednesday in 30A.D. the year Yeshua was crucified. And I counted the three days and three nights as such:

If Passover occurred on Wednesday Aviv 14th

In 30a.d. Passover occurred on Wednesday!

Tuesday: Pre-Seder **Jn.13:1,2,29**

Wednesday: Passover – Yeshua sacrificed- Buried right before sunset- night 1 in grave – **Jn.19:31,42**

Thursday: Day 1 of Unleavened Bread- Day 1 in the grave- Night 2 in the grave

Friday: 2nd day of Unleavened Bread- Day 2 in the grave- Night 3 in the grave

Saturday: 3rd day of Unleavened Bread- Day 3 in the grave

Saturday at Sunset: End of Shabbat- Beginning of First Fruits- Resurrection of Messiah- **Jn.20:1**

However, after further studies, I am now convinced that Yeshua actually ate the Passover meal on the same day that all of Israel ate the Passover which was the end of the 14th going into the 15th. They ate the Passover on the beginning of the 15th. The lambs are sacrificed in the twilight- on the 14th when the sun sets until dark.

Scriptures confirming that Yeshua ate the Passover:

Matthew 26:17 Now the first *day* of the *feast of unleavened bread* the disciples came to Jesus, saying unto him, Where wilt thou that we prepare for thee to eat the passover?

Mat 26:18 And he said, Go into the city to such a man, and say unto him, The Master saith, My time is at hand; I will keep the passover at thy house with my disciples.

Mat 26:19 And the disciples did as Jesus had appointed them; and they made ready the passover.

Mat 26:20 Now when the even was come, he sat down with the twelve.

Mark 14:12 And the first day of unleavened bread, when they killed the passover, his disciples said unto him, Where wilt thou that we go and prepare that thou mayest eat the passover?

Mar 14:13 And he sendeth forth two of his disciples, and saith unto them, Go ye into the city, and there shall meet you a man bearing a pitcher of water: follow him.

Mar 14:14 And wheresoever he shall go in, say ye to the goodman of the house, The Master saith, Where is the guestchamber, where I shall eat the passover with my disciples?

Mar 14:15 And he will shew you a large upper room furnished *and* prepared: there make ready for us.

Mar 14:16 And his disciples went forth, and came into the city, and found as he had said unto them: and they made ready the passover.

Mar 14:17 And in the evening he cometh with the twelve.

Mar 14:18 And as they sat and did eat, Jesus said, Verily I say unto you, One of you which eateth with me shall betray me.

Luk 22:7 Then came the day of unleavened bread, when the passover must be killed.

Luk 22:8 And he sent Peter and John, saying, Go and prepare us the passover, that we may eat.

Luk 22:9 And they said unto him, Where wilt thou that we prepare?

Luk 22:10 And he said unto them, Behold, when ye are entered into the city, there shall a man meet you, bearing a pitcher of water; follow him into the house where he entereth in.

Luk 22:11 And ye shall say unto the goodman of the house, The Master saith unto thee, Where is the guestchamber, where I shall eat the passover with my disciples?

Luk 22:12 And he shall shew you a large upper room furnished: there make ready.

Luk 22:13 And they went, and found as he had said unto them: and they made ready the passover.

Luk 22:14 And when the hour was come, he sat down, and the twelve apostles with him.

Luk 22:15 And he said unto them, With desire I have desired to eat this passover with you before I suffer:

John 13- even here is a picture of Yeshua eating the Passover, but some including myself have misinterpreted this for a Pre-sader.

3 days and 3 nights

Matthew 12:40 For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

If Passover occurred on Wednesday Aviv 14th

In 30a.d. Passover occurred on Wednesday!

Wednesday Evening: Passover – Yeshua ate the Passover Seder Meal.
Matthew 26:17-20/Mark 14:12-18/Luke 22:14-15

Thursday: Day 1 of Unleavened Bread- Yeshua was crucified at 9am and died during the day at 3pm. Day 1 in the heart of the earth- Night 1 in the grave. **Matthew 27:57/Luke 23:44-46/Mark15:42/John19:42**

Friday: 2nd day of Unleavened Bread- Day 2 in the grave- Night 2 in the grave.

Saturday: 3rd day of Unleavened Bread- Day 3 in the grave- Night 3 in the grave.

Saturday at nightfall: End of Shabbat- Beginning of First Fruits- Yeshua Resurrected from the grave on First Fruits sometime during the night, probably before the sun came up. **Matthew28:1/ Luke 24:1/John 20:1**
